About Herpes Treatment

- Herpes disease is a viral infection of two types of viruses.
- Antiviral medicines and painkillers help to provide relief symptoms.
- Antiviral drugs also help to prevent the reoccurrence of the symptoms.
- Outbreaks can be managed with some home remedies as well.

Topical Pain Relievers

- These are medications that are directly applied to your skin that help to reduce the burning sensation by providing a numbing effect.
- The common topical generic creams are lidocaine (such as Aspercreme and Anbesol), camphor and phenol (Campho-Phenique), and benzocaine.
- These topical drugs help to relieve the rash by reducing pain and itching.

Oral Pain Killers

- Tylenol (acetaminophen) is a prescription-based [antiviral medication for herpes](#) rash.
- Other oral over-the-counter medicines are also used.
- Common oral OTC medicines are ibuprofen and naproxen which help control swelling.

Lysine Ointment

- Lysine is a molecule, which is an amino acid that is presumed to have an antiviral effect.
- There are several ointments for cold sores such as Lip Clear Lysine Plus.
- However, such ointments are not scientifically proven to be effective against cold sores.
